

Using WinDOT on the Web

OPENING WinDOT

- Internet Explorer Version 9 or later is required. Other browsers such as Chrome or Firefox work well.
- Open the site <http://www.windot.com/default.aspx> and bookmark the site for easy access later
- Sign in with your email address and the password provided to you. This password can be changed later if desired
- The opening screen shows the items included in the subscription as active links.
- Select an item and click to open

IMPORTANT: The service is licensed to a single user and may not be shared with others.

RAPID UPDATE SERVICE

On a daily basis, ViaData monitors the Federal Register, DOT, state agencies and other sources and notifies users via email. The WinDOT content is updated to ensure that it stays current. There may be a day or so between the Rapid Update email and the WinDOT content update

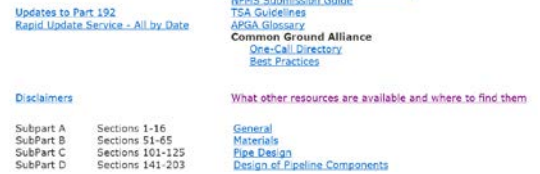
USING WINDOT on the Web

Navigation

The left hand pane contains the document's Table of Contents



The right hand pane on the opening page shows the table of contents and other relevant documents



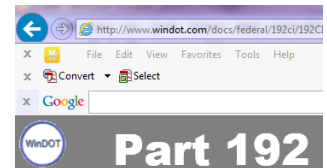
- To view a specific section, click on the Table of Contents (left or right)

Use the **browse button** to move forward or backward



Note the **Print button** between the browse arrows

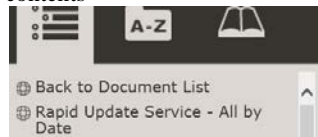
Use the **back arrow** to return to the previous view



To return to that start of the document, click on the header



To return to the Document List, select from left hand table of contents



Glossary:- click on the **Book Icon** Scroll through the list, or enter a term in the filter box. Glossary terms also appear as *maroon* text in the document. Click to expand

Searching. Full Boolean search capability is available. Terms such as AND and OR can be used in the search (example pipe AND corrosion). The search for an exact phrase, enclose the search item in quotes (example "wall thickness"). There is a drop down box to use to specify how many search results you want to see on your list with a default of 15. Search terms are highlighted in the resulting search hits
